We've all heard about the "summer slump", but who wants to sit around doing flash-cards and worksheets? Join the summer Read-a-Thon instead! This is a great opportunity for our kids to keep up their reading skills!

All children who participate will receive a ribbon (Grades K-2) or medal (Grades 3-5) in the Fall!

How Does it Work?!?

Any rising K-5 student can participate. To enter, you must do the following:

- Read the required minimum number of books over the summer:
 - Rising 5th Graders: 5 8 Chapter Books
 - Rising 4th Graders: 5 8 Chapter Books
 - Rising 3rd Graders: 5 8 Chapter Books
 - Rising 2nd Graders: 20 30 Grade Level Books
 - Rising 1st Graders*: 30 35 Books
 - Rising Kindergarteners*: 30 35 Books
- Enter all the books you read into the Reading Log.
- Hand in your reading log by Friday, October 6th!

The goal is to have your child read about 30 minutes a day. Good online sources for books are raz-kids.com, goodreads.com and nypl.org. If you are in need of additional reading suggestions for your child, please contact Denise after July 10.
